Members noted the latest financial statement regarding the budget.

CG23 Budget

Members noted the application for assistance with the costs of restoring the stained glass windows, the amount for which had been left up to the Council to decide. It was noted that the total project cost was £10,304.

**CG24 All Halls,
Kirkburton –
Restoration Appeal**

The Clerk advised the Council needed legal advice on its powers in respect of this application. She also updated the members on the situation regarding the donation of the Council's stained glass windows to Kirkburton Parish Church.

Resolved: To recommend that subject to confirmation that the award is legal, the Council makes a grant of £3,000 at the present time, and also indicates to the applicant that the financial situation will be reviewed at the end of the financial year, with a view to making a further award should the budget allow.

Members considered the application for £7,500 towards the cost of replacing the current rundown accommodation.
