The following personal interests were declared: Cllr Barraclough in Farnley Tyas Bowling Club; Cllr Hutchinson in the application from Rowley Lane JI&N School, as he is a member of Kirkheaton Methodist Church, whose members will benefit from the facility.

Cllr Hirst declared a prejudicial interest in Rowley Lane JI&N School, as he sponsored the application.

Resolved: To conduct the discussion of all the applications in private session due to the financial nature of the business to be transacted.

Members considered the application for £10,000 to contribute towards the costs of upgrading the outdated tennis courts to provide a multi surface facility.

Resolved: To award £5,000 on condition that the School provides a written report explaining how they will engage with the wider community.

Cllr Hirst re-entered the meeting.

Members discussed the application from Shepley Cricket Club for £20,000 to contribute towards the costs of replacing the changing rooms, including the installation of new drainage and a replacement septic tank.

Resolved: To request further information from the applicant regarding the total amount raised and spent, and to enquire if there are any facilities for girls playing at the Club.

Members noted the third quote received from the Club for refelting the roof.

CG29 **Farnley Tyas
Bowling Club**

Resolved: To confirm the grant of £6,000 to contribute towards the cost of refelting the roof, payable when the remainder has been raised
