Members noted the attached sheet giving full details of the works required at the churchyard, as well as the estimated cost for each job, and an estimate of the costs for the current contract repairing the wall on Church Lane.

**K7 Outstanding
Works at the
Churchyard**

Resolved: To recommend that Council uses the remainder of the allocated reserves to fund Jobs 1 and 5 and that £7,000 is put into next year's Kirkheaton Churchyard budget to cover the costs of Jobs 2 and 3, further tree felling and the grass cutting.

The Clerk was asked to draw up detailed specifications in preparation for putting the contracts out to tender in the New Year.

Members discussed the problems with the memorial to the children who died in the mill fire, which is in need of some repair.

K8 Memorial

Resolved: That Cllr Holroyd and Cllr Sykes would speak with the Vicar and Parish Clerk about the ownership of the memorial and possible funding available for its repair.
